GIVING BEYOND THE GRAVE

This is the time in the Christian calendar when we zero in on Jesus' resurrection **from the grave**. The view from Jesus' baptism to the crucifixion, provide a blueprint on how to live and how to die in the faith. Jesus' words in John 10:18 "No one can take my life from me. I sacrifice it voluntarily" signal a posture, a mannerism we should mimic. Mimic with a spirit of duty and nonconformity. Jesus gave **beyond the grave** and we can as well.

Amazingly, in our present day, we just witnessed a true **giving beyond the grave** example, right here in Canfield UMC. On Sunday, March 19, the family of Mr. Gary F. Rist presented a check for \$18,805.60 to the church. The giving was the culmination of Gary's wishes in his will, to have the contents of his home set to auction, for a gift to the church. In like generosity, in 2009 and 2016, Gary gave four sets of artwork to CUMC: a nativity set, a Noah's ark set and two New Testament scripture pictorials. These collections came from Gary's vast experience as owner and operator of Herron Interior Design Company.

Second Corinthians 9:7 says: Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

Churches receive charitable contributions every week. Yet a large-scale charitable **giving** is considered philanthropic. This kind of **giving** is based on an individual's desire to improve society by donating financially.
