# Pastor's Ponderings – Growing in God

In 1 Corinthians 3:5-9 the Apostle Paul shares with the church in Corinth about his ministry and the disciple Apollos ministry. Read the passage and reflect:

### 1 Corinthians 3:5-9 NIV

<sup>5</sup> What, after all, is Apollos? And what is Paul? Only servants, through whom you came to believe—as the Lord has assigned to each his task. <sup>6</sup> I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God has been making it grow. <sup>7</sup> So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow. <sup>8</sup> The one who plants and the one who waters have one purpose, and they will each be rewarded according to their own labor. <sup>9</sup> For we are co-workers in God's service; you are God's field, God's building.

Paul makes note that he and Apollos are only servants of God and that each has a ministry task. Paul planted a seed for God's Kingdom and Apollos watered the seed, but God makes faith grow. Paul goes onto write that the one who plants and water the seed is not anything but that only God makes things grow. Paul says we are co-workers in God's service that we are God's field and building.

I am reminded in this time of pastoral change that Rev. Ivy Smith at Canfield UMC and Rev. Ken Gifford at Poland UMC have used their unique God given talents to lead the congregations and community in growing in God's grace and love. From time to time as Christians we need to be reminded that God's church is bigger that an individual pastor. That as clergy and laity, we bring gifts from God to do ministries that help us all grow in Jesus Christ's grace and love.

Over the years of growing up as a preacher's kid, I have been parts of United Methodist Churches in Sharon Center, Ashland, Mount Gilead, and Poland, Ohio. As a pastor of fourteen years, I have served churches in the Freeport, Cardington, and Mansfield, Ohio areas. I have lived in rural areas such as Freeport that had a population of 350 people to suburbs in Mansfield to the inner-city areas of Dayton and Youngstown. No matter where I have lived, I have been amazed of how God works within people's lives. People need the Lord, and the church needs to be the Body of Jesus Christ that brings his saving grace and love to people from all walks of life.

God used Paul and Apollos to grow the early faith of Christians. God wants the churches of Canfield and Poland to grow the faith of the people in the surrounding communities by us embodying the grace and love of Jesus Christ.

My wife Robin and I look forward to using the gifts and graces that God has given us to help the churches and communities we serve to Grow in God. Remember we are God's field and I pray that we would water one another with the Living Water that is Jesus Christ our Lord. Let's grow together and bloom in Christ's grace and love that the world will take notice.
