This training event is open to all members of the Poland and Canfield United Methodist Churches. I encourage all members of both churches to attend and learn about the Simplified Accountability Structure for of leadership for local United Methodist Churches.

The Simplified Accountability Structure forms a board of nine church members that combined the church duties of the administrative council, the trustees, financial council, and the staff pastor relationship committee. Through combining the church councils and committee's local churches have less committees to fill and chair and it opens people to be part of ministry teams that get people to do ministries in the church and in the community. This meeting is an informational meeting to help learn more about the Simplified Accountability Structure and how it works within the life of the church. This is a worthwhile training for both the Canfield and Poland UMC's members to attend that will have an impact on doing fruitful ministries going forward.
