# Pastor's Ponderings – Fruitful Practices

During the month of October, I will be preaching on Bishop Robert Schnase's book Five Practices of Fruitful Congregations: Radical hospitality, Passionate worship, Intentional faith development, Risk-taking mission and service, Extravagant generosity.

Heading into this next year of ministry the Canfield and Poland United Methodist Churches will be developing practices of ministries that share the grace and love of Jesus Christ within the congregation and the communities we serve. Read and keep in mind the Apostle Paul's reflection on the Fuit of Spirit in Galatians 5:22-25 (NIV):

<sup>22</sup> But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. <sup>24</sup> Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. <sup>25</sup> Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.

The Five Fruitful Practices are areas of faith that we as a church can work together with as well as connecting new people to the church and having a spirit of Jesus Christ grace and love.

As a church we will work on Radical hospitality on how we greet people on Sunday mornings and how we greet people out in the world with a spirit of faith that shines the grace and love of Jesus Christ. Passionate worship will be something that we will be working on and evolving with as the Holy Spirit guides us. Intentional Faith development will take form in small groups such as Bible studies and Fresh Expressions of faith as we interact with the world sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ. Over the next year we will be engaged in Risk-taking missions and service that get us more connected with people in the world and call us outside of some of our comfort zone. The churches will be practicing Extravagant generosity through give on time to ministries in the area of children ministries, youth, and adults. Extravagant generosity will include doing a financial pledge to support the life of ministries in the church and communities we serve.

Through all that the Holy Spirit and Jesus will be doing in our lives and the life of the church we will together need to have a spirit that shares the Fruit of the Spirits. When we live in and share the Fruit of the Spirit people will take notice in how we care for an interact with one another and the world and they will want to know more about Jesus Christ and his Church. As we work together in the months ahead let us be start to bear God's fruits by loving one another and share Jesus Christ grace with each other and the world and fruit for God's Kingdom will blossom.
