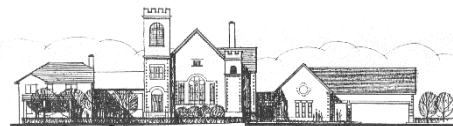

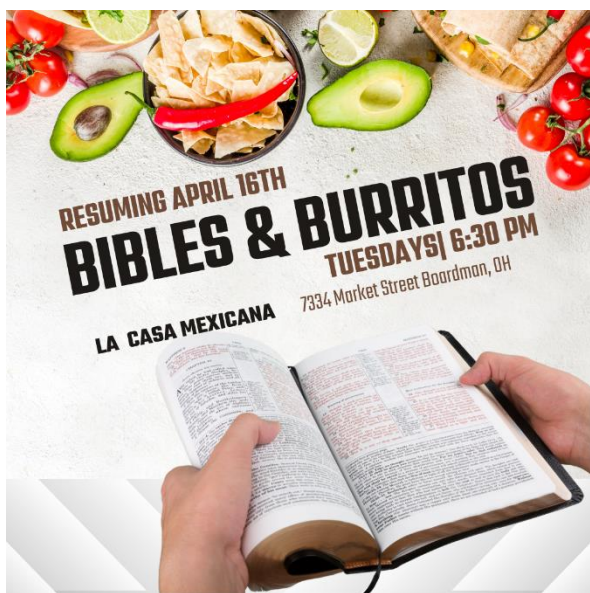
Pastor's Ponderings

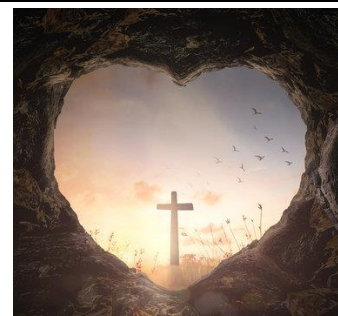
