Serving the Stranger

In July the Canfield, Poland, Boardman, and Otterbein United Methodist Churches went on a mission trip to serve the people of Steubenville, Ohio. When you go on a mission trip, you encounter new people that need some care. The four churches worked with the Urban Mission Ministries of Steubenville which is a United Methodist missional outreach. People in the area we served had many needs and benefited from some help in various aspects of their lives. I am reminded of the scripture passage from Matthew 25:

³⁵For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, ³⁶I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me.' ³⁷"Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you something to drink? ³⁸When did we see you a stranger and invite you in, or needing clothes and clothe you? ³⁹ When did we see you sick or in prison and go to visit you?' ⁴⁰"The King will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.'

On the mission trip we encountered people that needed something to eat, and with the Urban Mission food pantry we helped to serve 1000 people per week. There were people in need of clothes and the Urban Thrift store provides clothes and household goods at \$5 a bag. The mission team from our churches cleaned rooms to paint and helped to repair a wheelchair ramp. A community garden overcrowded by weeds was cleared and the crops tended. At the end of the week the churches hosted a block party picnic. We provided a hot dog cook out with food and cold drinks along with games and activities for people to do together. It was great to serve strangers and to get to know the people of Steubenville. I encourage you to not be a stranger and to serve the people around you by caring for all of God's people. Remember when we serve the people around us, we serve God and help to bring Jesus Christ's grace and love into the world.
