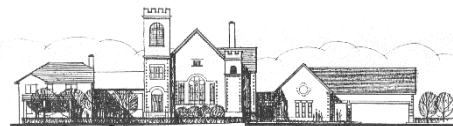

## Pastors Ponderings

## Where Two or More Gather

During the month of November, I will be preaching the sermon series entitled “Give Thanks to God” and both Poland and Canfield United Methodist Churches will be doing a Giving Pledge drive to support the Ministries of the church for coming year. Canfield UMC will be raising money for a new Audio-Visual equipment for the church that will include replacing the old projectors. During the month of November, I will be asking the two churches to Give Thanks to God for the blessings we have in our lives and the ministries we have in the churches. In November we will be looking to gather to have fellowship and place of praise to God as we grow in Jesus Christ’s grace and love in our churches and greater communities. Read the passage from Matthew 20: <sup>19</sup> “Again, truly I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything they ask for, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven. <sup>20</sup> For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them.”

Both Poland and Canfield UMC’s will be doing pictorial directories in November. You and your loved ones can attend a photo session at either church. The photo sessions will be on November 21st 2 p.m. - 8:30 p.m. at Poland UMC, November 22nd 2 p.m. - 8:30 p.m. at Poland UMC, and November 23rd 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. at Canfield UMC. November 2nd at 6 p.m. at Youngstown Trinity United Methodist Church (30 W Front St, Youngstown, OH 44500), the Poland and Canfield UMC’s will have the Fall Charge Conference. All members are welcome to attend the Fall Charge Conference.

Starting on November 5th, 7 p.m. at Poland UMC I will be leading a Bible study that will rotate week to week between Poland and Canfield UMC’s. We will be starting the Bible study by using Rev. Jim Harnish’s book The Disciples Path that will give us background on what it means to be United Methodist and our history. All are encouraged to be part of the study and let me know if you will need a book. Over this next year both churches will be looking at forming more small groups and for ministries to do together. Remember when we gather Jesus Christ calls us to be the Body of Christ in our churches and communities.
