A Journey of a Life

As we come into this Advent Season that leads into Christmas day, it is easy to be distracted from the real reason for the season, which is to celebrate the birth of the world's Savior, Jesus Christ. Too often during the season of Advent, we get caught up in the material gift giving of Christmas and we miss the gift of grace and love that Christ brings to the world. Through Jesus Christ's gift of saving grace, we are born again into a new life full of his inherent grace and love. Read and reflect upon 1 Peter 1:3-5 "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to obtain an inheritance which is imperishable and undefiled and will not fade away, reserved in heaven for you, who are protected by the power of God through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time."

Through Christ's grace, we have received a gift of mercy and been born again into a new life with a living hope that comes through the resurrection of Jesus Christ. As Christians when we keep the faith in Christ's grace, we have an inheritance that will not fade away and is reserved for us in heaven.

In this Christmas Season, I encourage you to give thanks for what Jesus Christ has done in your life. 
